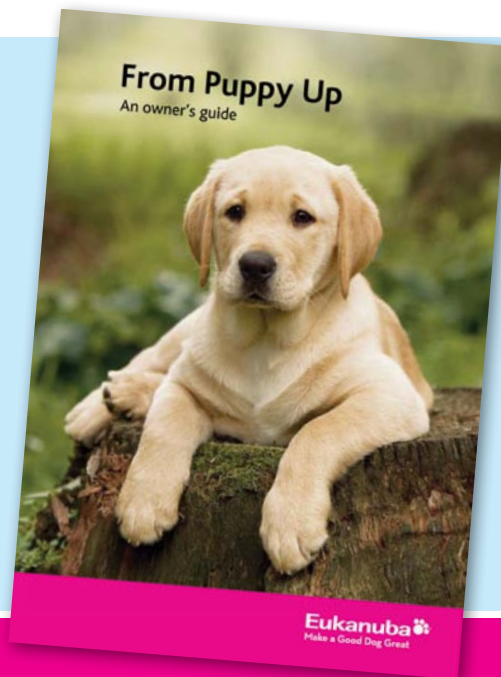

## Hugh's News

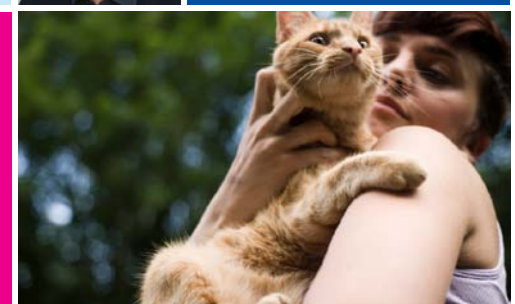
**Are you aware that many animals are euthanised in Australia each year due to behavioural problems?**

In many cases this is due to breed type, with the "working dogs" being the ones that predominantly get bored and cause the problems. It is often also due to the fact that animals have not been given the opportunity to undergo the social training needed as they advance through "Puppy-Hood" to blend into the family. As veterinarians, we inevitably see the stress and heartbreak that is caused by euthanasia/re homing and we feel that we need to address this issue. Our staff members are currently developing services to assist you in the choice of your family pet with the creation of the "Family Fit Program". We currently run Puppy Pre-school classes at both locations; we are working towards the development of a Puppy Prep program (for those pups older than 16 weeks). Our Veterinary Nurses will soon be available for behavioural consults and where necessary referral to animal behaviouralists such as Dr. Cam Day.
