**Hydrobath & towel dry**

Medicated baths (Malaseb, Pyohex) have a \$5 surcharge

**Small > \$15 Medium > \$20 Large > \$25**

**Hydrobath, blow dry & brush out**

Includes 15 minute brush out. If coat requires longer brushing time, this will be charged out at \$5 per 5 minutes.

**Small > \$35 Medium > \$40 Large > \$45**

**Blow dry & groom**

Factors that determine final costing are - behaviour, coat condition, extra assistance needed. All grooming includes nail trim, ear clean, eye clean and bottom clean up (as required). If extra assistance is needed during grooming, this is charged out at \$10 per 10 minutes.

## Grooming your pet

Dogs and cats of all coat types and lengths will need grooming throughout their lives. It may be as quick and simple as a daily brush at home, or it may involve professional grooming such as clipping throughout the year.

## Why it is important

Neglecting to groom your pets properly leaves your pet uncomfortable and, in some cases, in pain and may result in health problems such as skin infections. When regular brushing and bathing has not been done, knots and matts can form.

Grooming our pets gives us a chance to check their skin and general appearance. Things such as lumps, rashes and other health issues can be picked up during grooming. At Care Veterinary Group you can be reassured the health and well being of your animal is priority.

## Knots and matts

A knot is a small clump of hair which has become tangled, and these can often be brushed out. Mattes are knots that have been left for an extended period of time. The hair has become tightly bounded together close to the skin. Mattes CANNOT be brushed out; they need to be clipped out.

## Clipping

Dogs and cats of all different coat types and lengths can be clipped. If you don't have the time for maintaining a long haired coat, getting your pet clipped regularly will help improve their appearance and health.

## Bathing

Regular bathing keeps your pet clean and smelling great. It is important to only use shampoos designed for bathing pets. Dogs and cats have a different pH to us and human shampoos will dry out the coat and skin. Remember if you are using top spot flea control such as Advantage and Frontline, wait until 48 hours after bathing to apply, as per manufacturer's recommendations.

## Bookings are essential

Please note price ranges are given as an indication only prior to grooming. Coat condition and your pet's behavior determine final pricing.
