Why should my puppy and I go to preschool?

Remember the first two to four months of a puppy's life are the most important. Anything that happens to them during this period can affect them in the future. This is a great age to teach them basic obedience; such as sit, down, come and heel. The lessons include information and play sessions with other puppies.

Vaccinations essential

All puppies are required to be vaccinated, so please contact us prior to class commencement to arrange this.

Learn all about

Socialisation: why socialisation is important and how to go about ensuring your puppy is well socialised.

Desexing: learn about the benefits of desexing.

Microchipping: permanent identification for your pup.

Behaviour: learn the basics - sit, drop, recall, and stay.

First aid: what to do in emergencies.

Surgery tour: get to see "behind the scenes".

Parasite prevention medicines: information and samples of products currently available for your puppy.

Nutrition: learn about the difference between a mediocre and premium diet.

Grooming: advice on what to use for your puppy breed.

Dental care: maintenance of healthy teeth and gums.

What does puppy preschool involve?

The course runs for four weeks and classes are one hour long. In this hour the puppies enjoy playing, learn some basic obedience and we teach you about the common problems that we face owning a puppy. At puppy preschool you also get lots of treats and samples to try.

What do I need to bring?

The only things you need to bring are your puppy, a collar (please no choker chains), a lead and your enthusiasm! The whole family is welcome.
